Cost Share - Hurricanes *Katrina and Rita*

The cost share for permanent work, Categories C-G, is 90/10. This is retroactive to August 29, 2005 for Hurricane Katrina and September 24, 2005 for Hurricane Rita, and applies for the duration of the disaster operation.

The period for 100% federal reimbursement of Category A & B work (i.e., Debris Removal and Emergency Protective Measures) has been extended through midnight on June 30, 2006.

- All Direct Federal Assistance provided through Mission Assignments and sub-taskers completed by midnight June 30, 2006 will have a 100% federal cost share.
- All eligible debris removal and emergency protective measures completed by midnight June 30, 2006 by an applicant using its own forces or contract services will be reimbursed at 100%.

As of July 1, 2006, all remaining debris removal and emergency work will be funded at the 90/10 cost share.
