Description of Dispute

Determine the eligibility of electrical work performed by the applicant immediately following the event to shut off power and ensure electrical systems within buildings are safely restored. The FEMA determination is that the work performed was code enforcement and thus not eligible.


Unified PAPDT Decision

The applicant has appealed the determination in accordance with FEMA's appeal process described in Title 44 C.F.R. §206.206. Accordingly, no determination will be made by the Unified PAPDT.

The PAPDT recognizes the applicant's position regarding the dispute, which is the work performed was a direct result of the disaster, and necessary work to protect public health and safety and to protect improved property. The PAPDT will ensure the applicant's position is brought forward to the appropriate officials responsible for the appeal determination under Title 44 C.F.R. §206.206.
