Description of Dispute


Determine if the eligibility of replacement clarifiers due to corrosion.

Unified PAPDT Decision

The applicant has appealed the determination in accordance with FEMA's appeal process described in Title 44 C.F.R, §206.206. Accordingly, no determination will be made by the Unified PAPDT.

The PAPDT notes the applicant's eligibility dispute, which is that FEMA's eligibility determination does not adequately consider the corrosive damages resulting from inundation of brackish water. The applicant's position is that additional work resulting from the event should be deemed eligible to repair the clarifiers.

The PAPDT will ensure the applicant's position is brought forward to the appropriate officials responsible for the appeal determination under Title 44 C.F.R. §206.206.
